
Sermon Based Small Group Questions

- 2. How is verse 4-5 good news to you?
- 3. What does Paul mean when he says "chosen to be holy and blameless in his sight?"
- 4. Many people have argued that if God's choosing happens before the creation of the world, there is no need to share the gospel. Everything is already pre-determined. How would you respond to this?
