### Preparation

1. Before meeting together, read through Ephesians 1:3-14 on your own. Jot down 10 things that Christ has done for his church that are mentioned in this passage.

### Opening

2. Share with one another some ways you experienced God's goodness and love over the summer.
3. Share the 10 things you jotted down.

### Engaging

Read Ephesians 1:3-14 together

1. What are the spiritual blessings of being in Christ that Paul describes in verse 3?
2. How is verse 4-5 good news to you?
3. What does Paul mean when he says "chosen to be holy and blameless in his sight?"
4. Many people have argued that if God's choosing happens before the creation of the world, there is no need to share the gospel. Everything is already pre-determined. How would you respond to this?
